

CHAPTER 5

SUMMARY AND SUGGESTION

5.0 INTRODUCTION

Faisal Tehrani's written novel is an important reference to be debated because the indie novel is not just a story and dialogue, but more than that brings together a number of ideologies and thoughts that are contrary to the teachings of Islam. The indie novels discussed are a sign that unethical writing as well as fulfilling the wishes and tastes of the writer should be observed so as not to irritate other indie novels. If the influx and dumping of indie novels in the country is not stopped then it can disrupt and threaten the integrity of Islam in terms of faith, sharia, and morality.

5.1 SUMMARY

After fully examining a writing written by Faisal Tehrani, several objectives can be outlined, namely:

- (i) **Examine indie novels in Malaysia published by publishers in Malaysia**

It is common knowledge that indie novels have been on the market for the past few years. In fact, publishers who operate in the country privately cannot be controlled by the Ministry of Home Affairs and there is no authoritative body that acts to view, monitor, and ensure that each publication is in accordance with the guidelines that have been given. Therefore, a syariah committee should be established for every book publisher in Malaysia so that they understand the duties and responsibilities in ensuring that the content and writing produced by authors in the country meet the appropriate requirements and guidelines.

(ii) Exposing to bookstores in Malaysia about the dangers of indie novels

Bookstores in Malaysia such as POPULAR, MPH, SMO Books Store, Kinokuniya, Badan Cemerlang and all bookstores in both urban and rural areas should be given detailed disclosure of the contents found in indie novels so as to give implications that large against bookstores that distribute as well as sell purely profit-oriented books and this awareness should be given to all booksellers.

The dangers of the dumping of the indie novel market must be exposed in stages so that each individual is responsible in ensuring that the medium of books is not a new nest in spreading this unhealthy understanding and ideology.

Naturally the description, notification and observation need to be done seriously as this indie novel phenomenon has spread to become a major group in the publishing world in this country.

(iii) Provide guidance to book publishers to produce novels based on the true principles of da'wah

Islamic norms require the principle of da'wah as recommended, which is to call to the path of Allah SWT. As the Prophets and Messengers were assigned to convey the message and avoid the elements that can interfere with the purity of Islam is always challenged. Therefore, guidance to book publishers to produce novels based on the true principles of da'wah should be applied. If religious elements are to be included, they must meet the publication procedures as prescribed.

Publishers should be careful in accepting, compiling, publishing writing that will cause a writing that will only cause controversy so that the reading material is limited and can not be obtained and distributed to the general public. The beliefs of Ahl Sunnah wa al-Jamaah should always be an important position for all publishers in this country so as not to harm not only individuals but also readers in particular so as to make Islamic knowledge is something superficial and always debated through the balance of reason alone.

5.2 SUGGESTIONS

In general, this research gives some suggestions to publishers, authors, readers to understand the ethics of writing in producing novels in this country. Through this study, it can be seen that the author himself should be given the opportunity to be called by the Johor State Fatwa Committee before any decision will be taken on this indie novel.

In addition, some suggested suggestions are as follows:

5.2.1 Educational measures to the community and the younger generation including counseling teachers, resource center teachers, students, mass media in order to understand the dangers of indie novels.

5.2.2 Closed dialogue measures to book sellers, so that they do not sell indie books whose data and findings have been reported

5.2.3 Measures to convey a message about the dangers of indie books to national security and domestic leaders at all levels in a manner and method appropriate to their position.

5.2.4 Appropriate legal action should be taken against those who commit offenses under the relevant acts as well as the legal implications for publishers who publish such writings.

5.2.5 Writers in print and electronic media including in websites and new media need to be monitored so that distortions of the beliefs of Ahl Sunnāh wa al-Jamaāh do not occur in this country.

5.2.6 Establish a special committee that acts to confront and demolish the ideology of indie groups, especially appropriate and fast media channels to be a reference to Muslims

5.2.7 Conduct appropriate, accurate and strategic studies, knowledge discourse and academic research to explain and answer issues related to indie novels

5.2.8 Hold a competition to write Islamic da'wah novels with the cooperation of government bodies, the private sector or any party to produce writing that meets and complies with the true teachings of Islam

5.2.9 Supervise indie novels from entering schools because they will be reading material for teenagers and students at the primary and secondary levels as well as higher education institutions in the country

5.2.10 Provide continuous training to new writers who want to publish da'wah writing in the country, including writing novels

5.3 CONCLUSION

Members of the Johor State Fatwa Committee are always sensitive in every matter, including the publication of books in the country, giving them the opportunity to discuss, study and research indie books and novels in the country. The religious authorities should remain active so that not only the affairs of the fatwa cease to be matters involving the law alone but more than the writing of novels also affect the society in general. Therefore, the role played by the *Mufti* and his entire leadership should be an example to other Religious Departments.
